The route to coffee at Ongar Sports Club goes past the entrance to the Kelvedon Nuclear Bunker.

There is an option to visit the Nuclear Bunker, CM15 0LA, shown on the route sheet. This option may be of interest to riders following the route sheet. The current cost to visit the Nuclear Bunker is £15.00 per adult.

There is a canteen at the Nuclear Bunker for tea, coffee & snacks.

The riders following the run leader however will continue on to coffee at Ongar Sports Club.

The lunch stops for both routes would be at Ashfields Country Kitchen.

Route No 6 Suggested Friday Run.

Arranging a Friday night Fish & Chip supper at Battlesbridge is difficult. We can however have a Fish & Chip lunch instead at The Glasshouse at Peldon on Friday, it is their speciality. Afterwards we ride straight back to visit the Motorcycle Museum at Battlesbridge.
